RUMBAFEST POSTPONED

Rumbalara Football Netball Club's 2020 season launch event Rumbafest scheduled for Saturday 21st March 2020 – is postponed until further notice.

The health and safety of the community is, as always, our top priority.

As a community organisation, we must act in our collective interest. We must all play a role “flattening the curve” to reduce the impact of COVID-19 in our community. The Club is following Government advice, cancelling all nonessential gatherings following the declaration of a state of emergency in Victoria as of 12 noon Monday 16 March 2020.

The Club has decided that given the escalating concerns around COVID-19, for the safety and wellbeing of our members, guests, staff and the broader community, we feel it's best to postpone our event.

The Club has cancelled its scheduled practice matches and will continue to explore alternatives for players to continue training; however, we acknowledge the situation is fluid and any decision may change.

The Club's mission is to strengthen the community and bring families together through strong, vibrant leadership. This can only be achieved by providing the safest possible environment and putting the wellbeing of the community at the core of all decision making.
